Definition



Amblyopia (lazy eye):

- Is a disorders of sight;
- In an eye;
- Out of proportion to associated structural problems of the eye.

* AAO (American Academy of **Ophthalmology):**

: V.A < 20/50< 3 y.o</p>

: V.A < 20/40 **4-10** y.o

: V.A < 20/25 or 2 line difference > 10 y.o

Epidemiology



❖ 95% unilateral amblyopia.

Risk factors:

- Smoking, drugs, alcohol during pregnancy;
- Premature children (4 times)
- Children with delay mile stones (6 times)

- * 3.624 children from 3 to 17 y.o;
- from 2002 up to now;
- follow up: 1 24 months;
